# African Regional Population Conference Accra, Ghana. 9-18 December 1971.

#### Theme :

The International Union for the scientific study of population and the United Nations Economic Comission for Africa will hold a Regional conference on Population in African development (PAD) in Co-operation with the International Planned parenthood Federation (IPPF).

This conference will take place from 9 to 18 December 1971, in Accra, Ghana. The theme of the conference will be the contribution which the sience of demography can make toward raising the standard of life of the African peoples.

The programme is arranged to give oppurtunities for a comprehensive review of population characteristics, prospects and policies in the region and of how the increasing knowledge and understanding can best be used in development planning.

There will also be group meetings on special topics of demographic methodology.

## Presentation of Papers:

There will be five type of papers for the conference :

- (a) Organisers statement.
- (b) Solicited papers presented by individuals at the request of organisers of sessions (no more than five papers per session).
- (c) Back ground (or working) papers presented by the UNECA secretariat and other international agencies.

- (d) Contributed papers presented spontaneously by individuals who wish to take part in the conference.
- (e) Conntry statements which will be prepared by African countries.

### The Statistical Conference

The Institute of Statistical Studies and Research holds annual statistical conferences to cover various aspects of theoretical as well as applied statistics, the following topics are included.

Financial statistics, social statistics and family planning, health statistics, agricultural statistics, demographic statistics and economic statistics.

The eighth conference will be held in march 1972, in the mean time the Scientific Computation Centre will hold his annual conference on electronic computation.

Representative from Arab countries paricipate in this conference, which help to increase understanding and co-operation besides improving statistical knowledge in the Arab Nation.

Participants must present a summary of the papers they wish to discuss before the end of december 1971, the papers has to be delivered before 15th February 1972 to the conference secretariat.
